

ATKINSON CONSERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES

July 10, 2004

Scott Kukshel, chairman, called the meeting to order at 7:40 pm. Quorum was present.

Mike Saviano presented a copy of an application on his property Tax Map 20 Lot 12 33 Boulder Cove Rd, abutting Big Island Pond. Pete McVay is an abutter. He lives in the adjacent condominium complex. Mike stated that the reason he was present is that he was told by NHDES Shoreland personnel, Darlene Forst, that he should submit a copy of his application to the local conservation commission. So he was present to submit a copy and answer any questions the commission might have. The application is required per RSA 483-B: 9V (b) (2) (A) (1). Mike described the property and what work he proposed to do. Site is about 13 ft from edge of lake. Commission was unsure as to their role in this application process, since this was the first shoreland application that had been brought to a conservation meeting, and whether or not the commission had any role in recommendations to the state as in dredge and fill applications. The consensus was that although the commission wasn't sure of its role in this type of permitting, that the commission had no issues with the application.

Tim Dzichowski moved and Paul Wainwright seconded that the commission had no issues with the variance requested as it had been presented. Passed Unanimously Peter McVay abstained as abutter
